| Wednesday 31 st January Thursday 1 st February | DRAWING | This class will concentrate on drawing landscapes. Proportions, volume, tone and line will be studied. Light and shade will be emphasised. Graphite, Conte and Charcoal will be explored. |
| Wednesday 7 th February Or Thursday 8 th February | PAINTING | This class will look at composition, light and shade of the traditional life setting. Emphasis will be placed on the colour wheel, colour mixing and how to handle dimensions of brush stroke control. |
| Wednesday 14 th February Or Thursday 15 th February | OIL PASTEL WORKSHOP | This oil pastel class will explore the best ways to learn blending, shadow, highlight and colour mixing to create layers of colours. We will look at Vincent van Gogh's Starry, Starry Night and see how we can interpret this image. |
| Wednesday 21 st February Or Thursday 22 nd February | POTTERY | This popular pottery class is back again this term. Learn how to make a small pinch pot and create a wonderful clay sculpture. |
| Wednesday 28 th February Or Thursday 1 st March | ILLUSTRATION & NARRATIVE | Children will be asked to create a short narrative and add illustration to create a book. Because it is only one week, we ask that the Children bring a prepared short story to this class. |
| Wednesday 7 th March Or Thursday 8 th March | DRAWING BIRDS & ANIMALS | The intricacies of drawing birds and animals will be explained, with a focus on creating volume and texture. The tutors will work closely with the children to ensure they have a clear understanding of how to draw realistic images of animals and birds. |
| Wednesday 14 th March Or 15 th March | JEWELLERY MAKING | This class we will expand on previous jewellery making classes and children will create a variety of pieces. |
| Wednesday 21 st March Or 22 nd March | WATER COLOUR PAINTING | The children will learn to use transparent washes of water colour paint to create a seaside or country landscape. |
