| Wednesday<br>18 <sup>th</sup> April<br>or<br>Thursday<br>19 <sup>th</sup> April | <b>DRAWING</b>                      | This class will concentrate on drawing landscapes. Proportions, volume, tone and line will be studied. Light and shade will be emphasised. Graphite, Conte and Charcoal will be explored.   |
| Wednesday<br>2 <sup>nd</sup> May<br>or<br>Thursday<br>3 <sup>rd</sup> May       | <b>PAINTING</b>                     | This class will look at composition, light and shade of the traditional life setting. Emphasis will be placed on the colour wheel, colour mixing and how to handle dimensions of brush stroke control.                                |
| Wednesday<br>9 <sup>th</sup> May<br>Thursday<br>10 <sup>th</sup> May            | <b>OIL PASTEL WORKSHOP</b>          | This oil pastel class will explore the best ways to learn blending, shadow, highlight and colour mixing to create layers of colours. We will look at Vincent van Gogh's Starry, Starry Night and see how we can interpret this image. |
| Wednesday<br>16 <sup>th</sup> May<br>or<br>Thursday<br>17 <sup>th</sup> May     | <b>POTTERY</b>                      | This popular pottery class is back again this school holiday. Learn how to make a small pinch pot and create a wonderful clay sculpture.  |
| Wednesday<br>23 <sup>rd</sup> May<br>or<br>Thursday<br>24 <sup>th</sup> May     | <b>POTTERY</b>                      | This week will be the second week of the pottery class where students will paint their work or glaze ready for firing if they so choose.  |
| Wednesday<br>30 <sup>th</sup> May<br>or<br>Thursday<br>31 <sup>st</sup> May     | <b>ILLUSTRATION &amp; NARRATIVE</b> | Children will be asked to create a short narrative and add illustration to create a book.
