Day	Program	Description
Wednesday 18 th July Thursday 19 th July	DRAWING	This class will concentrate on drawing landscapes. Proportions, volume, tone and line will be studied. Light and shade will be emphasised. Graphite, Conte and Charcoal will be explored.
Wednesday 25 th July Or Thursday 26 th July	PORTRAIT PAINTING	This class will teach the children how to draw and paint a Portrait ready for our Little Archies Portrait Exhibition. Form, structure, tonal values will be studied. The children can use either water colour or acrylic paints to create their portraits. A photo of someone they want to paint would be beneficial.
Wednesday 1 st August Or Thursday 2 nd August	OIL PASTEL WORKSHOP	This oil pastel class will explore the best ways to learn blending, shadow, highlight and colour mixing to create layers of colours. We will look at Vincent van Gogh's Starry, Starry Night and see how we can interpret this image.
Wednesday 8 th August Or Thursday 9 th August	POTTERY/CLAY SCULPTURE	This popular pottery class is back again this school holiday. The children have the choice to make a pinch pot, a coil pot, or a slab construction. We will also be giving them the opportunity to create a 3D portrait which will be cast in plaster (or bronze at parent's discretion)
Wednesday 15 th August Or Thursday 16 th August	POTTERY/CLAY SCULPTURE	This week will be the second week of the pottery class where students will finish their work from last week and either – cast, paint or glaze ready for firing if they so choose.
Wednesday 22 nd August Or Thursday 23 rd August	ILLUSTRATION & NARRATIVE/ BOOK MAKING	Children will be asked to create a short narrative and add illustration to create a book. Because it is only one week, we ask that the Children bring a prepared short story to this class. The Children will be taught how to make this short narrative into a hand made book.
Wednesday 29 th August Or 30 th August	WATER COLOUR PAINTING	This fun class will teach the children how to work with water colour pigment as opposed to opaque acrylic or poster paint.
Wednesday 5 th September Or 6 th September	MOSAICS	This is popular mosaics class will create a small piece so that the children have time to complete in one session. We usually make this a two week class, but we want to give them as much variety as we can during the term
Wednesday 12 th September Or 13 th September	DRAWING BIRDS & ANIMALS	The intricacies of drawing birds and animals will be explained, with a focus on creating volume and texture.
Wednesday 19 th September Or 20 th September	JEWELLERY MAKING	This class we will expand on previous jewellery making classes and children will create a variety of pieces, including the popular Tree Of Life.
